

We give thanks this weekend for our mothers and grandmothers — women who brought children into the world and nurtured us to maturity. As children, we relied on them for support, nourishment, protection and encouragement. As adolescents we took mothers for granted, abused their kindness, and ignored their council. In our adulthood, mothers often become our friends and confidants. In their old age, many mothers begin to rely on their children.

While most of this can be said of fathers, there is a unique bond between mother and child that lasts a lifetime. Understanding this bond gives us a glimpse of our relationship with God — the feminine side of God. Like our mothers, God receives whatever we dish out. No matter what we do, God has an inexhaustible supply of grace for us. While mothers are finite and there is a limit to their strength, they share this receiving characteristic with God.





Parishioners who tuned into the 9:30 am Mass last Sunday were thrilled to witness the Choir virtually present, visible and singing, their images projected just above their normal 'choir area' in the apse:



This technological wizardry was first debuted at Easter, and is the work of parishioner Samuel Leung. Fr. Nick and our concelebrant priests are able to sing along with the musicians in perfect synchrony, with Samuel himself live on the piano.
