SCENES FROM THE ANNUAL PARISH CONFERENCE



Last Saturday, over 50 members of our parish gathered together on Zoom to prayerfully reflect on the theme chosen by Fr. Nick and the Parish Pastoral Council for this, our 4th Annual Parish Conference: *Evangelization at St. Mary Magdalen and in our surrounding communities*. The conference, moderated by **Deacon Jeff Burns**, **Ph.D.**, was divided into two parts: The morning session was devoted to a presentation by our keynote speaker, Jesuit Scholastic **Joel Thompson**, **SJ**, followed by a Q&A. After a two-hour lunch break (during which many took advantage of a delicious lunch prepared by *Agrodolce Osteria*), we regrouped to form seven small 'breakout' sessions, each group brainstorming on how our parish can approach one of the following topics in the context of evangelization: *The Arts*, *Social Justice*, *Environment*, *Becoming a Catholic*, *Welcoming Families back to the School and Church*, *Re-engaging Catholics*, and *Beyond Fundamentalism*.






