
# Pentecost

After Easter and Christmas, Pentecost is the third most important feast in the Church. The Book of Acts tells us that the Holy Spirit descended on the disciples this day, and the Church was born. From then on, the Church spoke out fearlessly about Jesus' death and resurrection and humankind's salvation.

There is some difference in opinion about when the gift of the Holy Spirit occurred. John's Gospel records it happening on Easter Sunday. The Book of Acts places it fifty days after the Resurrection. For liturgical purposes, the Church has used the latter date, or Pentecost. It helps the Easter season draw to a close, and signifies the end of the period of *Mystagogia* (a Greek word for *training*) for those baptized at Easter.

For us, Pentecost is a commemoration of the beginning of the work of the Church. We rededicate ourselves to ministering the Good News of Jesus Christ to the world around us. We renew our responsibility of living out our baptismal commitments. This won't necessarily take the form of formal missionary work or preaching, but it does mean that everything we do—in our families, where we work or go to school, in our encounters with associates and even strangers—must somehow reflect our belief in the Gospel.

As we move out of the pandemic with most of us being vaccinated, many of us are planning vacations for the first time in over a year. If there is a positive side to lock-

downs and travel restrictions, it is our increased awareness that we need direct human interaction. Zoom and GoToMeeting have helped us to cope, but there's no substitute for being there. Closer to home, this also means Church. As restrictions are lifted, I hope to see you at Mass on Sundays. *We need you* to make the Body of Christ complete, and *you need liturgy* so you can bring the grace of God sacramentally into your life and into the world. Pentecost is a reminder of our need to gather, then to go out and preach to the world.



#### How You Can Help Our Neighbors in Need


