Letter from Fr. Nick

Reopening the Parish

Dear Parishioners:

Two weeks ago, I outlined how I envisioned the reopening of Saint Mary Magdalen after the pandemic. Since then, the Diocese and State have lifted most restrictions concerning gatherings. Thus I am happy to share with you a timeline for retuning to normal. There is always a possibility that things can change again, but below is the schedule for reopening over the course of this summer:

June 15 <sup>th</sup>	Most restrictions are lifted. Facemasks, check-in and social distancing are no longer required outdoors.	Vaccinated people need not wear facemasks indoors.	Unvaccinated people wear facemasks on the honor system.
July 18 <sup>th</sup>	Concert & Cuisine Fundraiser	Renovated Parish Hall is reopened and rededicated.	
July 24 <sup>th</sup>	Livestream Mass moves to the 5:30 pm Saturday Vigil Mass.	Enables us to implement the full Mass schedule in coming weeks	The liturgy will be available on Facebook and YouTube.
July 24 <sup>th</sup> -25 <sup>th</sup>	Mary Magdalen Festival	In-person and Livestream events	
July 31 <sup>st</sup> -August 1 <sup>st</sup>	Full Sunday Mass schedule resumes.	8:00 & 11:30 am: Church. 9:30 am Mass: Dominican Garden	Mass in the Dominican Garden will continue through the end of the Summer.
August 15 <sup>th</sup>	Solemnity of the Assumption	Regular weekend Mass schedule	7:00 pm, Solemn Evening Prayer
August 29 <sup>th</sup>	Parish-School Picnic	Following the 9:30 am Garden Mass Liturgy	Proceed to Live Oak Park after Mass.






