

Blessing of Teachers

This weekend, as recognition that the school year is under way, we will bless our teachers at the 9:30 a.m. liturgy in the Dominican Garden. All faculty and aides from our school have been asked to be present so that we may honor and bless their endeavors. We are also inviting teachers, aides, principals and professors (including retired faculty) from surrounding schools, universities, and colleges to receive a special blessing, which will take place at every Mass this weekend.

Anyone who teaches knows that their work is much more a calling or vocation than a job. Teaching requires training, dedication and

commitment far in excess of what those who benefit from it can ever repay. Last year Covid-19 forced our teachers to do double duty, preparing in-person learning as well as videoconference classes.

It is significant that Jesus was honored with the title of "Teacher," even by those who were against him. We entrust our and our children's future to teachers in ways that are often invisible and unremarked. Even more than the information we learn from them, our teachers' examples strengthen membership in the Church and the civil community.

Beyond this blessing, how do we show respect and encouragement to our teachers? Many times it is through little habits that require some forethought. Speaking respectfully of teachers among ourselves and in front of our children powerfully communicates that we value teachers and their work. Trusting a teacher's good judgment in the classroom, and giving her or him the benefit of doubt when our children report an incident at school, powerfully aids their work and discipline in class.

Above all, teachers need our prayers. Building relationships and forming our children into models of Christ's love constitutes a sacred act, second only to parenthood.




