Notes from Fr. Nick

My Parents' Marriage

Tomorrow, September 20th, would have been my parents' 71st wedding anniversary. Although Dad died a couple of years ago, they managed 68 years together. Mom is now 93 and still living in the family home with my brother Tom, who is retired.

They first met when a doctor arranged a blind date between an art school student and my mother, a nurse. But the art student fell and broke his leg, and so he asked my father to stand in for him. My father didn't let on that he was a replacement, but the date apparently went very well, because they fell in love and were married. Later, the



doctor invited my parents to dinner aboard his yacht, and my father had to confess his original deception.

As the eldest of five children, I've been present for most of the ups and downs in my parents' marriage: the births of my three brothers and sister; frequent moves on account of my father's career as an artist, writer, and businessman; their world travels; their finally settling down in rural North Florida. My parents' relationship was both stormy and affectionate, but in later years they independently confessed to me they were more romantically involved than ever.

Marriage is the most peculiar of sacraments. Rather than being bestowed by the Church, the couple ministers the sacrament to each other. Weddings are a commitment of hope more than an accomplished sacramental fact. While Christ is visible from the beginning, it is only after looking back over many years of loving, fighting, caring, mourning, joy, and sorrow that the true sacramental pattern of Christ's presence emerges. My parents' marriage taught me more about the sacrament than I ever learned in the seminary.

My father's dementia in the months before his death two years ago strained the entire family's relationships. But, with a little distance from his passing, I'm able to appreciate my parents' commitment to each other. In many ways, it was working out Christ's presence in the very nuts and bolts of living, rather than an ideal to be imitated. In the end, that's what all sacraments are.


