## Reports

- Brian King provided a report on the Racial Equity Committee. The committee did some tabling at the entrances to worship spaces for the new Faith and Racial Equity course. They were able to get 18 sign-ups. Brian and Jim P. have not been able to get together yet to write up guidelines for the phone tree.
- Fr. Nick provided a report on the Mission Alignment Process. We are hoping to take the surveys this weekend during the masses. People need to bring phones. The survey will replace the homily. Fr Nick feels we will get more participation by doing the survey at Mass. Depending on how long it takes to do the survey, we may just help people to get into the port. There are 75 questions on the survey, he thought it is good to so many questions. Paper copies will be available. We want as many people as possible to do the survey. The hope is to get a profile the diocese can use to organize the diocese. Email blast with link and asking people to bring Laptops, ipads. The questions are not particular to our diocese. This is a National survey that has been developed in the last 15 to 20 years. The surveys due Nov 22.

All Saints we will have an additional mass even though it is not a Holy Day of Obligation. We will have an Altar of Remembrance during the month of November. We are having a Memorial Mass for those who died during covid. Our 2<sup>nd</sup> concert and cuisine fundraiser will be Jazz. We will keep the same arrangement with food and music like we did with Andy, Angelo d'Alo will provide the food. Jazz, instead of classical to broaden the appeal. Dec 12 is the procession of Our Lady of Guadalupe image from church to Dominican Garden, we will sing some hymns in honor of our Lady, then light the Christmas tree, sing Christmas carols. The Penance service is set for December 13. Fr Steven Bell, CSP will preach 5:30, 9:30, 11:30 the weekend of Nov 13/14.
