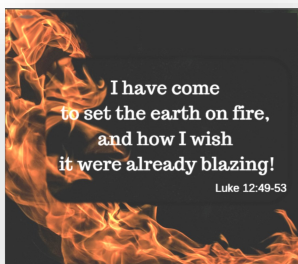

## Mass for Eunice Jackson



At 9:30 am today, August 14<sup>th</sup>, a Memorial Mass will be held for decades-long parishioner **Eunice Motte Jackson**, who entered eternal life on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021.

Eunice came to Berkeley in the 1950s, when her husband, Dr. John ("Jack") Jackson, finished his service in the Korean War. In the 1960s, with her three children in school, Eunice began her career in community service and volunteerism that continued for over fifty years. She was an engaged leader in many organizations, including the *School of the Madeleine Mother's Club, St. Mary's High School Parent's Association & Board of Trustees, the Bay Area Urban League & Bay Area Urban League Guild, and the San Francisco Chapter of the Links, Inc.*

Eunice founded and ran *Project Friend*, a weekly program in Berkeley for disabled young adults, for 21 years. She received numerous citations and awards, including the *Volunteer Bureau of San Francisco Service Award, the San Francisco Foundation Award for Outstanding Contributions in Human Relations, and the Bay Area Catholic Charities Woman of the Year.*

In addition to six grandchildren and fourteen great-grandchildren, Eunice was survived by her sister, Sr. Mary Brenda of the Oblate Sisters of Providence; sons Kenneth (Debbie Lee) and Harold (Laura); and daughter, Brenda Drake, whose husband, Michael, is the 21<sup>st</sup> President of the 10-campus system of the University of California.

Eunice was most recently remembered in our parish for her faithful service at every *Sunday Dinner for the Hungry* from the 1990s until she moved to Oakland in 2016. Parishioners and friends are warmly invited to attend her Memorial Mass, which will be followed by a dedication of a plaque in her honor in the Dominican Garden, and then a reception in Rengel Plaza (in front of Norton Hall).

Notes from Fr. Nick

## *The Feast of the Assumption*

Tomorrow we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Church teaches that at the end of her life on earth, Mary was assumed into Heaven in her glorified state as we will be at the end of time. With her death, Mary began the pattern of redemption that all people who have faith in her Son will follow. Like Mary, we will reach our full potential when we are united with Christ for eternity.

The dogma, constituted in 1950, is the most recent *infallible statement* issued by the Church. (There have been only two.) The psychologist Carl Jung—who was not Catholic—stated that it was “the most important religious event since the Reformation,” as it shows the ongoing revelation between God and human beings.

Normally, August 15<sup>th</sup> is a Holy Day of Obligation, but the U.S. Bishops have decreed that whenever a Holy Day of Obligation falls on a Saturday or Monday, we are dispensed from the responsibility. Regardless, the Solemnity is an opportunity for Christians to come together and celebrate our salvation in Christ through his magnificent plan that began on the Cross, continued through Mary, and will culminate with us.

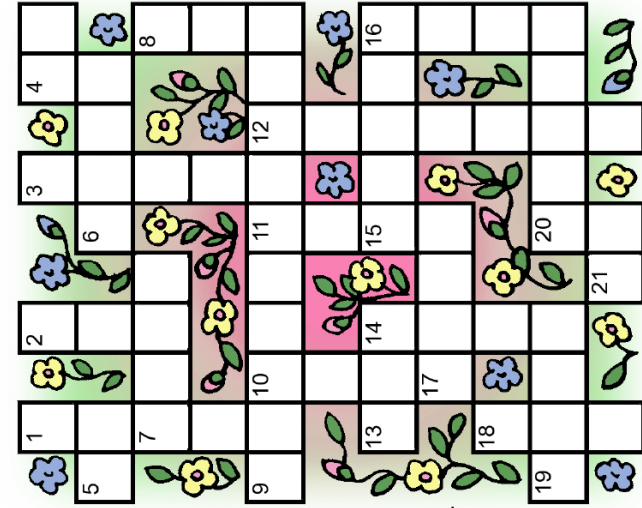
