

Notes from Fr. Nick

Our Sister Parish & Parish Conference

As part of a delegation from our parish, I'll be away this weekend visiting our Sister Parish in Mexicali. This is our first trip since Covid shut down travel in 2020. We hope this will be an opportunity to bring our two parishes and cultures together.

Our relationship with Santa Maria de Guadalupe was a natural one when the same Dominican Fathers ran both parishes. It seemed more important than ever after the Dominicans left St. Mary Magdalen that

we strengthen the bonds between the two parishes. In 2019 we visited Mexicali as a sign of our commitment to each other.

I believe the visit was an eye-opener for both groups. Among the many things we learned was that our needs and mission were very different, yet complementary. Homelessness is one of the biggest problems our community faces, yet in Mexicali it is almost nonexistent. That's not to say there is no poverty. The standard of living is lower in Mexicali than in Berkeley, but in comparison with much of the developing world, they are fairly well off.

Families and local communities are more cohesive in Mexico than here. Some studies show that Mexicans are the hardest working people on the planet, yet they still manage to keep their families at the center of their lives. We can learn a lot from our neighbors' commitment to civic engagement.

The Dominican Fathers of Santa Maria de Guadalupe take care of several churches within their parish, but the people remain committed to the Eucharist. While Mass can't always be celebrated every week in all four locations, the parish has adapted so that it hasn't lost its character.

We hope this excursion to our sister parish will promote much more interaction. I hope we can invite members of the Mexicali community to our centennial celebration and other events for years to come.

Parish Conference on February 11th

Next weekend, **Fr. Michael Sweeney**, **OP**, will be the keynote speaker at our Centennial Parish Conference. It will be the first gathering since Covid forced us to go online in 2021. It is also an inaugural event for our centennial celebration.

Surely there will be much talk about our history, but Fr. Michael's talk will look ahead. Using Pope Benedict XVI's teachings, he will discuss the need for a change in the mindset of many laypeople and clergy: Rather than seeing the responsibil-



ity of the laity to collaborate with a ruling clergy, they must learn. I'm looking forward to hearing his talk, and I hope you will be there to hear him, too.

Attending the parish conference *is your opportunity to participate in the "big picture" of our parish.* We have these annual conferences so that we can address the broad issues and opportunities facing our church. We will look beyond what the Parish Council, Liturgy Committee, and Finance Council address on a more frequent basis. It's your chance to have a "say".


