

Our Parish Mission

Beginning this weekend Fr. Jude Eli, OP, will lead our Centennial Parish Mission. Fr. Jude will preach at all our Masses on March 18th and 19th. Then on Monday through Wednesday (*see below*), he will give mission conferences. And as part of the Parish Mission, we will celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Tuesday evening, with Fr. Jude as our preacher.

Fr. Jude was ordained a priest of the Western Dominican Province in 1976. He has taught, preached, and been a campus minister throughout all his career. Media, particularly television, have been a major part of his ministry. In addition to catechesis, Fr. Jude had a long-running cooking show on KNTX in Fresno.



His mission is entitled, "The Accusations Against Jesus: The Passion Narratives." Fr. Jude will explore and explain the motivation and disposition of Caiaphas (the High Priest), Pontius Pilate (the Governor), Judas and Peter. I hope this meaty topic will set the stage for much personal reflection leading into Holy Week.

If your Lent is flagging, here is your opportunity to get back on track. Often we start out with great intensions, then after a few weeks, with Easter a long way off, our willpower begins to flag. Fortunately we can start over as often as necessary, and God's grace still is still there for us.

If you can't make the whole retreat, at least try for one evening; the Penance Service will be Tuesday evening. It's your opportunity to make your Easter Duty and clear your conscience in preparation for Easter.


the world have a great need of Eucharistic adoration."
