

Clergy & Scholar Mixer

As part of our centennial celebration, our parish will host a gathering of clergy and scholars from the area next Thursday evening, June 8th, from 6:00 to 8:00 pm. Unless I have missed out on something, there has been very little interaction between ministers in Berkeley since I arrived in the parish. Yes, some members of our congregations do work together on meals for the homeless, on social justice and some environmental matters. As well, Temple Beth El has gathered and prayed with us in the past. However, in the nearly six years I've been here at St. Mary Magdalen there has been no meeting where the religious entities of Berkeley have met, shared contact information, and enjoyed food and drink together.

Berkeley and Boston — and to a lesser extent New York, Chicago and Washington, D.C. — are among the very few cities in North America where many religious schools are neighbors and share resources. The presence of the Jesuit School of Theology, the Dominican School of Philosophy and Theology, and the Graduate Theological Union make Berkeley a preeminent center of theological study. I hope our gathering will be an opportunity for the scholars and local clergy to relax and mingle.

I don't have a tight agenda for this gathering. We have asked Rev. Lizette Larson-Miller (last year's Mary Magdalen conference speaker) to give a brief address, and Rabbi Rebekah Stern to offer an invocation, but beyond these planned talks, I expect that the chemistry of the gathering will allow the Spirit to work God's power among us. Sometimes it's nice to just share a drink and some good food in common!


