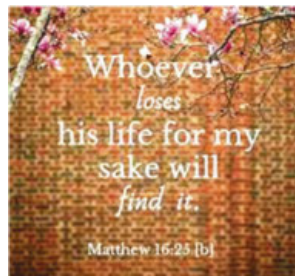

Independence Day



In 2012, I traveled to former “Iron Curtain” countries for the first time. Twenty years after the collapse of Communism, Saint Petersburg appeared to be still in the process of sloughing off the weight of oppressive rule. Strict oppression was all the Russians had ever known. Equally tyrannical Communists replaced centuries of brutal rule under the Tsars. In Russia, order is more prized than freedom. Yet our Russian tour guides displayed a sweetness and pride that was a little surprising. Without saying so

explicitly, they conveyed an earnestness that said they were trying hard to build a new society. I wonder what their private thoughts on the subject might be today.

Tallinn, Estonia, was doing better than Saint Petersburg, but they had lived under Soviet occupation for a much shorter time than the Russians had lived with totalitarianism. There was a wryness in the tone of the commentator at an Estonian history museum. It betrayed the lessons learned from years of subjugation under foreign oppressors who believed they had wiped out the spirit of a people. Estonia is too small to withstand major aggressor countries for long, but its people know how to keep its national spirit alive, even if they cannot always determine their own fate. Today they are once again in Russian crosshairs, but their alliance with the West has, hopefully, changed the balance in their favor.

Independence Day 2023 comes at an extremely cynical time in the life of our country. Although the presidential election is over a year away, the political battle lines have already been drawn. It’s easy to discount things we agree on and the freedoms we have always enjoyed. The rancor of the last few election cycles makes me a bit fearful. Visiting countries where democratic values are not taken for granted opened my eyes to the possible fragility of our own democracy. On Independence Day this year, I give thanks for my citizenship, and I pray that all of us will be vigilant in defending our basic freedoms; freedoms that people of other nations must fight for every day.

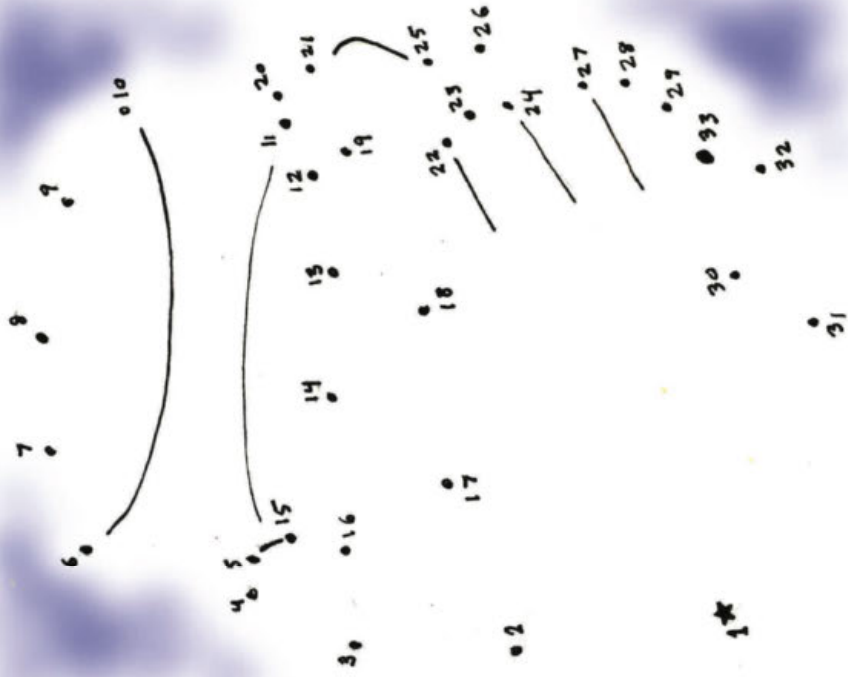

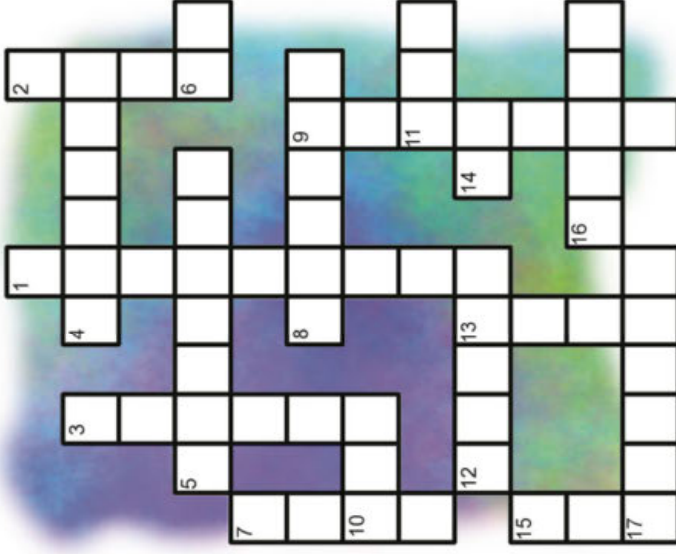
