



Welcome Home!



This Sunday we reach a high point in our centennial celebration. As we celebrate the feast of our patron, Saint Mary Magdalen, we look back over the last 100 years and ahead to a strong future proclaiming the Gospel on the north side of Berkeley. We recognize the character and charism of our parish community, and we grow from interaction with the larger community.

CELEBRATING 100 YEARS

First of all, welcome back to all of you who dispersed from our parish over the years and have come home to celebrate with us. Opportunities may have taken you away from Berkeley and our parish, but I hope you still feel a connection with us. Hopefully, you

have taken the spirit of Saint Mary Magdalen to the limits of our world and enriched those places in doing so. You will always have a home here.

Secondly, many thanks to the Dominican priests and sisters who so ably ministered in this parish for most of its life. The four pillars of Dominican spirituality—study, prayer, preaching, and community life—are still alive and well here. You have imbued these charisms in our parish and they inform our work and mission every day. Know that you always have a place in our church and school.


