

We are honored to have **Agbonkhianmeghe Orobator**, **SJ**, the new Dean of the Jesuit School of Theology (Santa Clara University) as our Keynote Speaker this year. Fr. Orobator grew up in Benin City, Nigeria, practicing traditional African religion. He saw the works of the American Jesuits as fully devoted to the service of others, resonant of an African anthropology of Ubuntu that teaches "a person is a person through other persons."


Fluent in four languages, Dean Orobator received his Ph.D in Theology from the University of Leeds in England, his MBA from Georgetown University, and his Licentiate in Sacred Theology from JST-SCU. His books include "Religion and Faith in Africa: Confessions of an Animist," and "The Pope & the Pandemic: Lessons in Leadership in a Time of Crisis."

Dean Orobator was present at Pope Francis' *Synod on Synodality* last October, and that will be his topic of discussion, as well as the format of the Conference itself.



## Centennial Gala!


