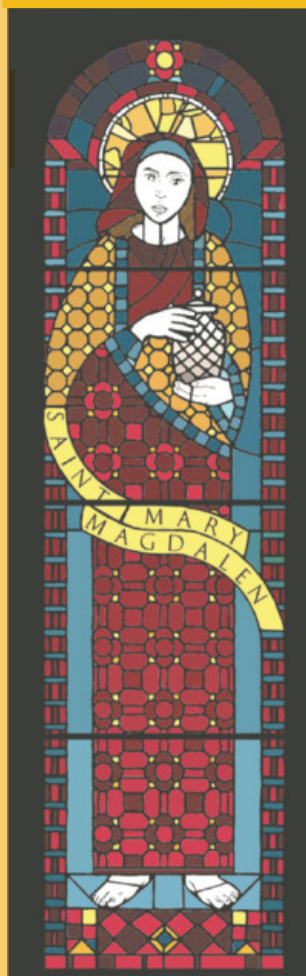

ANOINTING OF THE SICK:

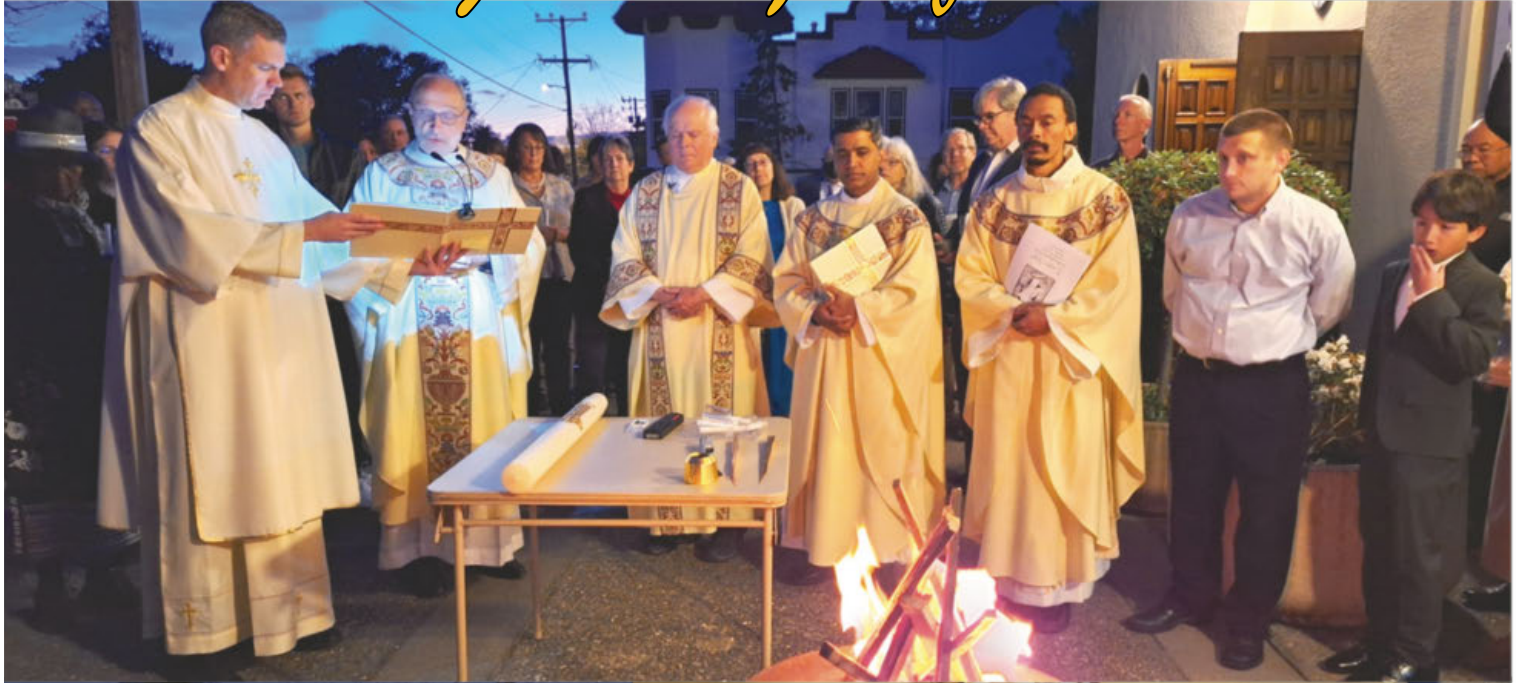
The Sacrament is offered at every 5th Sunday Mass, and by appointment.

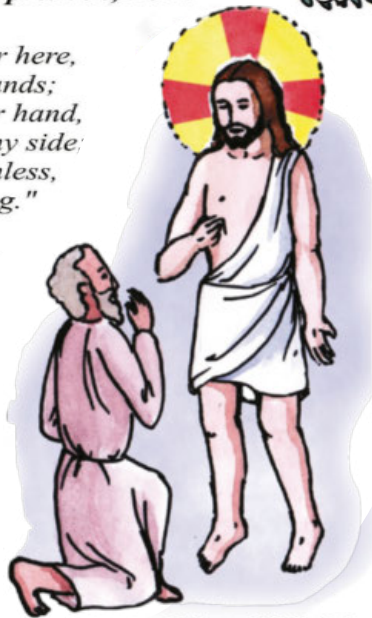
