Holy week begins with Palm/Passion Sunday which is the weekend of April 12/13. The primary events of Holy Week are Tenebrae on Thursday, April 17th, Friday, April 18th, and Saturday, April 19th, at 9:00AM in the church. On Thursday evening the Mass of the Lord's Supper begins at 7:30PM, followed by Adoration in Magdalen Hall. On Friday afternoon the Passion of the Lord with Veneration of the Cross service begins at 1:30PM. Also, on Friday, at 7:30PM, we prayer the Stations of the Cross. On Saturday evening, beginning at 7:30PM, is the celebration of the Great Vigil of Easter. On Easter Sunday of the Lord's Resurrection Masses are at 8:00AM, 9:30AM, and 11:30AM.
