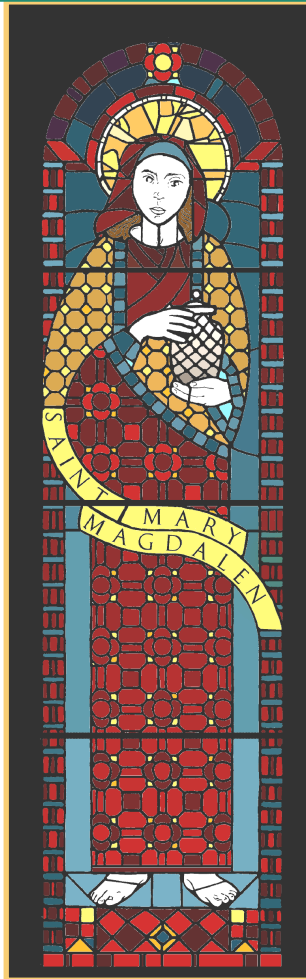

Father's Day



Last month I talked about the challenges facing women in general and mothers in particular. Although there is a unique character to motherhood, many traits are common to all parents. On this Fathers' Day, I'd like to reflect on the traditional roles assigned to parents, and how they may be challenged when duties are reversed.

Bob and Ceil Clark were active members of Santa Maria Parish in Orinda. Bob was a high-powered executive with a software firm in San Francisco. Ceil, while well-educated and qualified in her profession, was a stay-at-home mom. Successful as he was, Bob had the nagging feeling that something wasn't right. One morning he woke up and the issue was clear to him: he did not

know his children. Business occupied most of his waking hours. True, he was providing for the family's material welfare, but he was emotionally absent to them.

Bob and Ceil made a courageous decision: he became a stay-at-home dad and Ceil resumed her business career. They agreed on a future date on which they would assess their "experiment" and set about changing their lives. Bob navigated the unfamiliar territory of PTA meetings and grocery shopping. Ceil was a little hurt when their children would go to Bob to settle minor disputes and for emotional guidance. But they made it work, and they eventually decided to continue in their new roles until their children graduated from high school.

Once they got past the stereotypes of the macho "man's world" and demeaning connotation for "women's work," they found elements in each other's lives that they genuinely enjoyed. However, other matters they were not able to change. Ceil still faced the "glass ceiling" when she was passed over for promotions, and Bob sometimes wished he could "fire" his children as he could have a miscreant employee.

There was a learning curve. Bob didn't make this mistake, but I remember another lady in a former parish whose husband surprised her with a pie he baked, but he had used tartar sauce instead of crème of tartar! She genuinely was surprised. Humility was the order of the day.

Most parents will not try as radical an experiment as Bob and Ceil did, but we can learn to share tasks and risk not doing new ones well, at least for the first few times. Dads can read to their children (my father did). Moms might learn how to perform some plumbing repairs. Maybe the most important duty parents can do together (which rarely occurs to many) is to pray together in front of and with their children. The example this sets and the experiences it gives can bring your marriage and family to a level no one expects.

To all the dads out there who are the breadwinners, to all the dads who share household tasks, and to all those who nurture their children—Happy Fathers' Day!

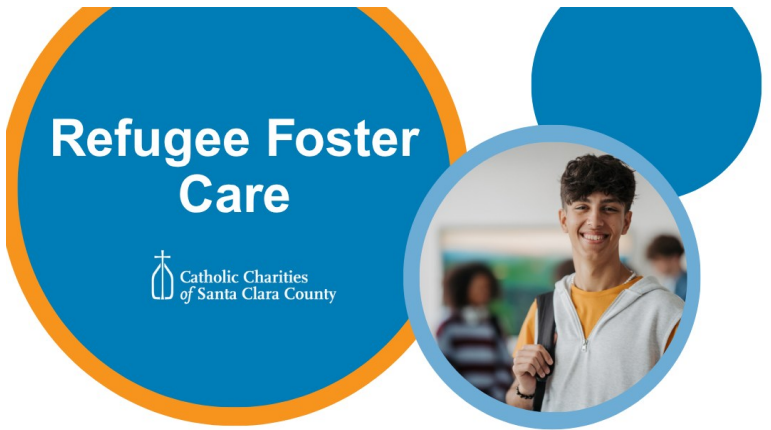
